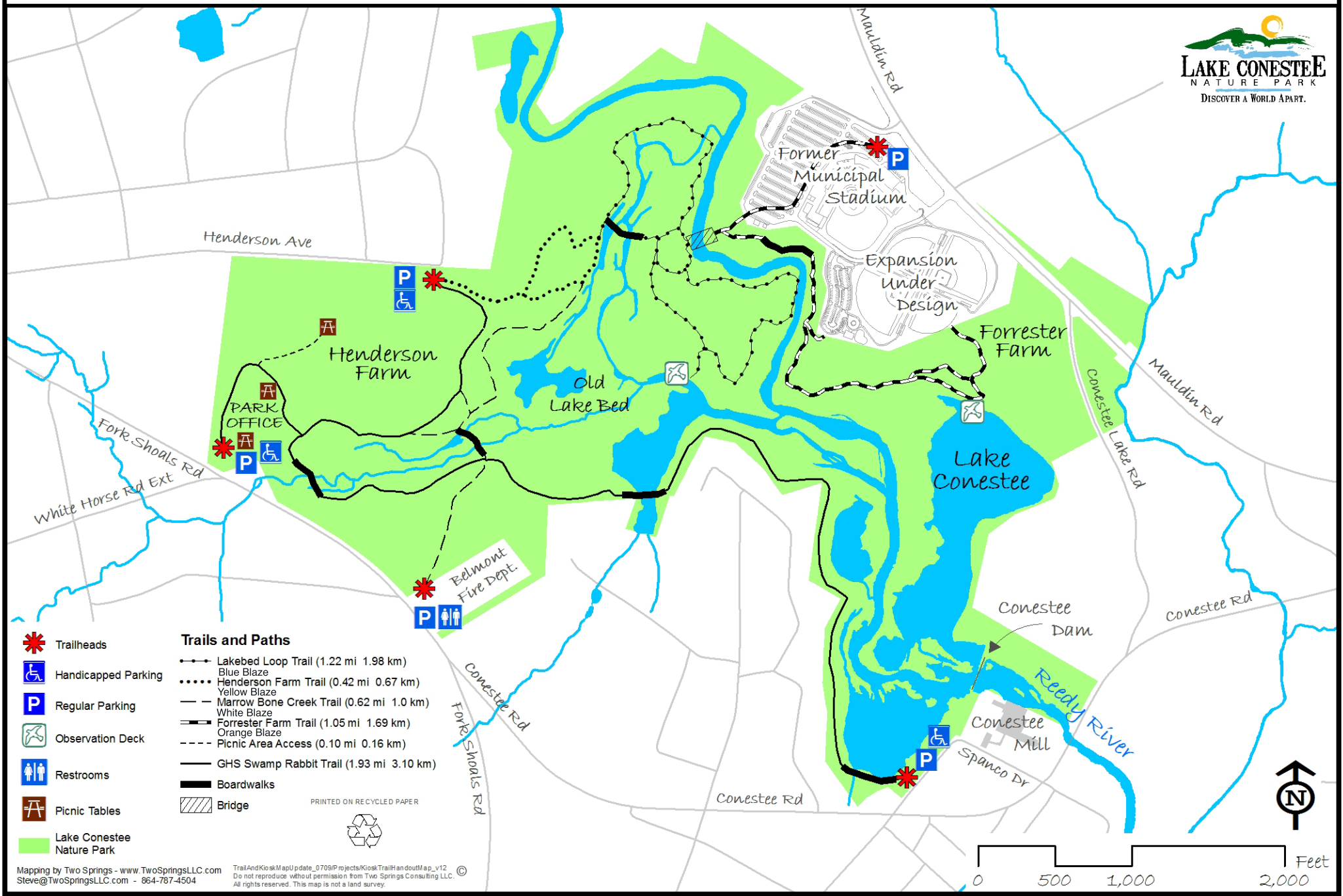


LAKE CONESTEE NATURE PARK - TRAIL MAP

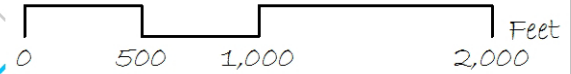

Lake Conestee Nature Park Rules

Welcome! The Conestee Foundation, a 501(c)(3) non-profit conservation organization, was established to spearhead the revitalization of Lake Conestee and the surrounding Conestee community with the development of a public nature park and environmental education center.

Some areas of this unique facility lay over ground and lakebed that have been injured by decades of human activities. We can all help Nature continue her healing processes by carefully reading and observing the following rules:

- The park is open from sunrise to sunset. It is the visitors' responsibility to return to the parking lot before the gates are locked.
- For your safety, observe all "Warning" and "Do Not Enter" signs. **STAY ON MARKED TRAILS AND BOARDWALKS.** Entering wetlands, lake, and streams are prohibited. Be alert for snakes, poison ivy, barbed wire and other hazards.
- In case of an emergency call "911" for first responder assistance.
- Practice *Leave No Trace* principles. Help keep LCNP clean by disposing of waste properly - Pack it in, pack it out. Waste receptacles are located at most trailhead parking lots.
- Alcoholic beverages, amplified music, camping, fires, fishing, hunting, motorized vehicles (except authorized vehicles and motorized wheelchairs), watercraft launching, and weapons of any kind are prohibited within the park.
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a leash and are not allowed to enter the water or wetland areas.
- Bicycles are permitted on all trails except the Lakebed Loop Trail and must be walked across all boardwalks.
