Five club members visited Wilson Farm on May 4 in cool, windy and cloudy weather. Highlights were both Solitary and Spotted Sandpipers, an Osprey, a Philadelphia Vireo, numerous White-crowned Sparrows (30 or more), and many Scarlet Tanagers (at least 7 or 8). Unfortunately, the Northern Waterthrush that was found there during the Spring Migration Count on April 27 was not seen or heard. The Killdeer is still on the nest that the farm owner spotted in time to work around.

In all we had 64 species for the morning.
