As participants in the Cornell/ebird Global Big Day 5 GCBC members visited Holliday Circle, Cedar Falls County Park and Gunter Road. The day started cool and wet but we ended the day with 60 species of birds. At Holliday Circle we watched a small tree at the top of a hill with a continually changing cast of birds. Further down the road we were able to get great looks at a cooperative Prairie Warbler. At Cedar Falls we had 9 species of Warbler including good showings by Magnolia, Kentucky and Redstart. At Gunter Road we were not able to find the Scissor-tailed Flycatcher but were able to ID 16 species of birds in the short time we were there. All in all a great day to be in the field!
