The best bird was a Black-billed Cuckoo, which is a new bird for the Wilson Farm list, bringing the total species seen there to 168. Several members went to the Hawk Watch on Caesar's Head after the Wilson Farm Outing. Chip Gilbert and Jeff Click reported that they saw, in addition to the raptors seen on Wilson Farm: Osprey, Sharp-shinned Hawk, Scarlet Tanager, Dark-eyed Junco, Peregrine Falcon (believed to be local to the area)
