Greenville County Bird Club Trip Report

Date: Saturday, March 21, 2015

Location: Lake Conestee Nature Park, Greenville, SC

Leaders: Denise DuPon and Paul Serridge

Two separate walks took place, both starting at 8 a.m.

The weather was perfect for birding with warm temperatures (between 48 and 62F), almost no wind, and good light.

The good weather and possibility of plenty of birds brought out more birders than we have seen at Conestee in a long time - if ever!

There was a total of 19 participants on the all-morning outing, although some arrived a little late and some had to leave early; the shorter outing attracted 15 participants, some of whom stayed longer than anticipated and extended the walk as far as the Bird Nest. The combined lists (see below) show a **total of 55 species**.

Highlights were first of the season Northern Rough-winged Swallows, an early Solitary Sandpiper (first ever in any month of March), and 2 Barred Owls, one of which was very close to the paved trail.

An excellent morning's birding was enhanced by good looks at a Muskrat feeding in the South Bay, and a 5 feet long Rat Snake on a fallen tree near the Reedy River bridge.
